#### **CELL PHONES / ELECTRONIC DEVICES**

In September, parents signed a Bring Your Own Device form for your child stating that you as parents acknowledged and supported your child having a device based on the expectations set out by the school and in accordance with the HWCDSB device policy. Recently, an increased number of concerns have come forward regarding students not using their device appropriately. Students should not be texting, taking pictures or accessing social media such as Instagram and Snapchat. As a result of this development, some classes cell phones are collected from students at the start of the day and given back just before dismissal. All cell phones are in a locked container and kept in the Principal's office. As a school we are currently deciding if this will be the practice for all classes/divisions. A note will be sent once a decision is made. If you need to reach your child, you will have to call the school at (905) 523-2340, as has always been protocol. Should your child not feel well and need to call home, a phone call will be placed by Mrs. Eterno from the office.

Although we as a school did try to offer students the privilege of using their device, it has been taken advantage of and therefore a Reconsideration and review of policy is now being considered.
